

## Leaflet Trademarks in Denmark

### Territory

The trademark protection covers the territories of Denmark, the Faroer Islands and Greenland.

### Duration

The duration of the trademark is 10 years from date of registration, and it is indefinitely renewable for like periods.

### Compulsory use

If the mark is not used in Denmark for the goods and services concerned within a period of 5 years from the end of the registration procedure or a subsequent period of 5 years there is a risk that the registration may be partially or totally revoked. However, a registration will only be revoked if a third party makes a request on this. Use of a mark by a third party with the consent of the owner (e.g., by a licensee) is sufficient use.

### Marking

Marking is not compulsory, but advisable, a usual marking being 'Indreg. Varemærke No ....' (followed by the registration number of the trademark); also the symbol '®' or '™' may be used.
