

Leaflet Trademarks in Peru

Duration

The duration of a mark registration is 10 years from the date of grant of the registration, and is indefinitely renewable for further 10-year periods.

Compulsory use

A registered trademark must be sufficiently used, failing which it will become subject to cancellation for non-use. If a registered trademark has not been used in at least one of the Andean Community Member Countries (Bolivia, Colombia, Ecuador and Peru) by the owner or by a licensee during three consecutive years without legitimate reasons, any interested party may request the Trademark Office to cancel the registration of the trademark.

Marking

Marking is not compulsory. Possible marking: 'Marca Registrada', or 'M.R.' within a circle, or '®'.

License

Licenses under a registered trademark may be granted. License agreements do not need to be registered in order to be valid in Peru. We recommend you to contact us if you intend to grant a license under your trademark in Peru.
