

## Leaflet Trademarks in Thailand

### Duration

The duration of the trademark is 10 years from the date of filing the application, indefinitely renewable for further 10-year periods.

### Compulsory use

There is no requirement to submit an affidavit of use to maintain the registration but a lack of use in Thailand of the registered mark for a continuous period of 3 years or more will make the registration vulnerable to cancellation on the ground of non-use.

### Marking

Marking is not compulsory. Marked products have no implications for awarding compensation in case of past infringement.

### License

License agreements must always be in writing and must be registered with the Trademark Office to be effective. We recommend you to contact us if you intend to grant a license under your trademark in Thailand.

### Border Control

To enlist for border control measures against counterfeit or imitative goods, recordation of the registered trademark with the Customs Department is advisable. We recommend you to contact us if you intend to have your trademark recorded at the Customs department in Thailand.
