Leaflet Patents in Switzerland and the principality of Liechtenstein

Territory

The patent covers the territories of Switzerland and Liechtenstein.

Duration

The patent has a duration of 20 years from the filing date, provided that the annual fees are paid in time.

Compulsory use

The patented invention should be sufficiently worked in Switzerland or Liechtenstein within 3 years from the date of grant of the patent or within 4 years from the date of the application, as to satisfy the needs of the Swiss market. If the is no sufficient working without valid reason, any interested party may apply for a compulsory licence. Not sufficiently working the patent also involves the risk of cancellation of the patent. Importation is deemed working of the patent.

Patentees who are citizens of Germany or the USA or are domiciled in either of these countries, and who work corresponding patents in their home country or country of domicile respectively, do not need to work their Swiss patent.).

Marking

Marking is not compulsory, but it is recommended to indicate the patented goods and/or their packaging as "+ No..." (the cross forming part of the marking being the Swiss Federal Cross.
