Leaflet Patents in Eurasia

Territory

The Contracting States of the Eurasian Patent Convention are Armenia (AM), Azerbaijan (AZ), Belarus (BY), Kazakhstan (KZ), Kyrgyzstan (KG), the Russian Federation (RU), Tajikistan (TJ) and Turkmenistan (TM). To maintain the patent in the desired Contracting States those Contracting States have to be designated and the accumulated annual fees have to be paid in each of those contracting states. Please notify us in which of the above contracting states your Eurasian Patent shall be maintained.

Duration

The duration of the Eurasian Patent is 20 years from the date of filing of the application, subject to the payment of annual fees in the related Contracting States.

Compulsory use

There are no provisions on working in the Eurasian patent law. In each Contracting State where the Eurasian patent has effect the working requirements will be based on the provisions of the national law of that State.

Marking

There are no provisions in the Eurasian patent law on marking of patent protected products, and marked products have no implications for awarding compensation in case of past infringement.

License

License contracts relating to a Eurasian patent must be registered in accordance with the national law of the Contracting States in which the Eurasian patent has effect. Please contact us if you intend to grant a license under your Eurasian patent.
