National patent number

No national patent number is assigned to the Czech part of the European patent.

Duration

Provided that the annual national renewal fees are paid, the patent has a duration of 20 years from the European filing date.

Compulsory use

A patented invention should be sufficiently worked within 3 years from grant or within 4 years from filing the application (whichever period expires last), failing which the patent will become subject to the risk of a grant of compulsory licenses.

Marking

There are no provisions as to marking. Possible marking is 'Patent č. ...' followed by the patent number. Marked products have no implications for awarding compensation in case of past infringement.

EU member countries

The Czech Republic is a member of the European Union (EU). As far as patents are concerned, this has the consequence that once products protected by the patent are sold by or with the permission of the patentee in one EU member country, shipment of these products into and out of other EU member countries basically cannot be prevented.
