

## Leaflet European Patent in Greece

### National patent number

The Greek part of the European patent will be assigned a national patent number.

### Duration

Provided that the annual national renewal fees are paid, the patent has a duration of 20 years from the European filing date.

### Compulsory use

Working of a patented invention is not compulsory under Greek Law. Nevertheless a compulsory license may be granted to a third party upon request if the patented invention is not worked.

### Marking

Marking of patented articles is not compulsory. If you refer to the existence of the patent you also have to indicate that the patent is granted without guarantee of the State as to the validity of the grant.

### EU member countries

Greece is a member of the European Union (EU). As far as patents are concerned, this has the consequence that once products protected by the patent are sold by or with the permission of the patentee in one EU member country, shipment of these products into and out of other EU member countries basically cannot be prevented.
