

## Leaflet European Patent in the Republic of Lithuania

### National patent number

No national patent number is assigned to the Lithuanian part of the European patent.

### Duration

Provided that the annual national renewal fees are paid, the patent has a duration of 20 years from the European filing date.

### Compulsory use

There are no provisions regarding compulsory use.

### Marking

If desired, articles protected by the patent may be marked with the word 'Patent' and the number of the patent.

### EU member countries

The republic of Lithuania is a member of the European Union (EU). As far as patents are concerned, this has the consequence that once products protected by the patent are sold by or with the permission of the patentee in one EU member country, shipment of these products into and out of other EU member countries basically cannot be prevented.
