

Leaflet European Patent in Latvia

National patent number

No national patent number is assigned to the Latvian part of the European patent.

Duration

Provided that the annual national renewal fees are paid, the patent has a duration of 20 years from the European filing date.

Compulsory use

If within 4 years after filing date of application or within 3 years after the date when the notification regarding the grant of a patent was published the patented invention has not been used or has been used to an insufficient extent in Latvia, any person may apply for a compulsory license at the administrative court.

Marking

Marked products may have implications for awarding compensation in case of past infringement. The proprietor of the patent and/or the licensee with the proprietor's consent may label products with warning marks by indicating the patent number. The name of the proprietor of the patent and the date of the grant shall be indicated on the warning mark.

EU member countries

Latvia is a member of the European Union (EU). As far as patents are concerned, this has the consequence that once products protected by the patent are sold by or with the permission of the patentee in one EU member country, shipment of these products into and out of other EU member countries basically cannot be prevented.
