

Leaflet European Patent in Romania

National patent number

No national patent number is assigned to the Romanian part of the European patent.

Duration

Provided that the annual national renewal fees are paid, the patent has a duration of 20 years from the European filing date.

Compulsory use

A patent should be sufficiently worked in Romania within 3 years from grant or within 4 years from filing the application, whichever period expires later. If a patent is not sufficiently worked without justified reasons within the said period in Romania, it may become subject to the grant of compulsory licenses.

Marking

Marking is not compulsory, and marked products have no implications for awarding compensation in case of past infringement.

EU member countries

Romania is a member of the European Union (EU). As far as patents are concerned, this has the consequence that once products protected by the patent are sold by or with the permission of the patentee in one EU member country, shipment of these products into and out of other EU member countries basically cannot be prevented.
