Leaflet European Patent in the Republic of Serbia

Territory

This part of the European patent covers the territory of the Republic of Serbia.

National patent number

The Serbian part of the European patent will be assigned a national patent number.

Duration

Provided that the annual national renewal fees are paid, the patent has a duration of 20 years from the European filing date.

Compulsory use

If the patent owner or a person authorized by the patent owner does not use the protected invention or uses it insufficiently in Serbia, an interested person may submit a request to the authority competent in the field in which the invention should be used in order to obtain a compulsory license, if the patent owner refuses licensing to other persons or sets unreasonable conditions for such licensing. A request cannot be filed before the expiry of a period of 4 years from the patent application filing date or 3 years from the date of the patent grant, whichever of these two time limits expires later.

Marking

Marking is not compulsory. When the patentee intends to notify the public of the patent protection in the Republic of Serbia, the national number should be referred to.
