# Leaflet European Patent in the Republic of San Marino

## **Territory**

This part of the European patent covers the territory of the Republic of San Marino.

#### National patent number

The San Marino part of the European patent will be assigned a national patent number.

### **Duration**

Provided that the annual national renewal fees are paid, the patent has a duration of 20 years from the European filing date.

#### **Compulsory use**

Patents must be worked in the Republic of San Marino or in Italy to an extent not seriously disproportionate to the needs of the Republic of San Marino within 3 years from the date of grant or within 4 years from the application date, whichever term expires later. Thereafter, the patent may not remain non-worked for longer than 3 consecutive years. The importation into San Marino of goods manufactured abroad amounts to working of the patented invention. In case of non-working, a compulsory license may be granted.

#### **Marking**

Marking is advisable, but not compulsory. Possible marking: 'Brevettato', or 'Brevetto', or 'Brev.', which may also be followed by the patent number, or 'Brevetto depositato', or 'Brev. Dep.', which may also be followed by the patent application number.
